

Before me Jeremiah Washburn one of the Justices  
of the Peace for the Republic of Texas, the County of  
Washington District of Lake Creek Personally ap-  
peared Alexander Whitaker who says that the an-  
nounced discharge is just and true and that he on  
the Government's side nothing on this or the annexed dis-  
charge but one pair of Shoes of a fine quality either  
for himself or any other person - Nor has he  
retained ~~any~~ arms or munitions of War or  
embezzled any kind of property belonging to the Republic  
of Texas or caused the same to be done

May 13<sup>th</sup> 1834

Before me the above Jeremiah Washburn per-  
sonally appeared Joseph L Bennett who says that  
he was present at the contract between the said  
Alexander Whitaker and his brother Peter, that  
this deponent heard said Peter say that he would  
give him the said Alexander all his right title  
and Interest of the above discharge provided  
him the said Alexander would serve out  
the balance of this present term of three  
months
