Know all men by these presents that Edwin
Corner aged 44 years do solemnly swear that
that I was, the identical Evan Corner that
volunteered under Capt William Weir as private
for three months, and under Col J Bennett
I volunteered on the first day of April A D,
one thousand eight hundred and thirty six
and was honorably discharged about the first
day of July A D, 1836. I the said Evan Corner
do also swear that I volunteered a second time
under P M Wade at Lake Creek Station settle
ment on or about 4th day of July A D one
thousand eight hundred and thirty six and
was discharged on or about 4th day of Oct A
D, 1836. I also declare that I ~~am~~ also that I
and the identical Evan Corner who obtained
a land warrant for 640 acres of land in 1838
the proof you will find on file in the General
Land Office This declaration is made for the purpose
of obtaining all pensions that may be deemed accord
ing to an Act of Congress the Legislature passed
August 13th A D 1870 entitled an Act Granting Pen
sions to the surviving veterans of the Revolution
which separated Texas from Mexico
