

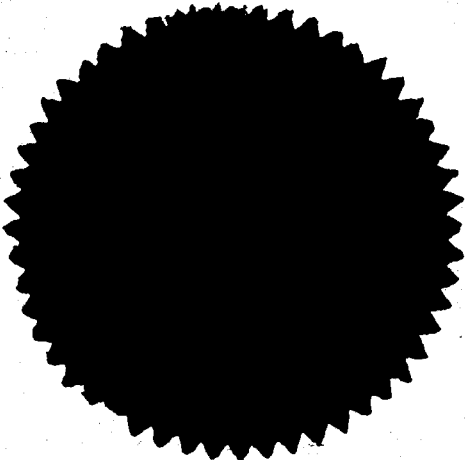
OATH OF IDENTITY.

Andrew J. Swell who being duly sworn according to
law, declares that he is the identical Andrew J. Swell
who was a Soldier in Captain Company
of the Resiment of
in the army of Texas; that he enlisted on the 15th
day of October A.D. 1835 for the term of Three months
and was discharged at San Antonio on the 11th
day of February 1836 by reason of the ex-
piration of his term of service; he having
served in the mean while several terms of
service with Capt. Martin, Madis &
