THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That *Frimmer*
Thomas Frimmer has, under the provisions
of AN ACT of the LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, entitled "An Act to provide for ascertaining
the Debt of the late Republic of Texas," approved 20th March, 1848, filed with the Auditor and Comptroller
a claim for services as 1st Sergt in Capt Bogart's
company in the Vasquez campaign
amounting to Forty Two $70/100$
Dollars; which is sufficiently authenticated to authorize the auditing of the same under the laws of the late Republic of Texas.
The said claim, according to the data before us, is worth Forty Two $70/100$
Dollars, in Par Funds, as having been at that rate so available to the Government.
