THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That John Trimmer has, under the provisions
of AN ACT of the LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS, entitled "An Act to provide for ascertaining
the Debt of the late Republic of Texas," approved 20th March, 1848, filed with the Auditor and Comptroller
a claim for services rendered Capt Bogard's
company on the Mexican campaign
amounting to Thirty one
Dollars; which is sufficiently authenticated to authorize the payment of the same under the laws of the late Republic of Texas.
The said claim, according to the data before us, is for Thirty one and 50/100
Dollars, in Par Funds, as having been at that rate so available to the Government.
