served faithfully and honorably in the army
of the Republic of Texas for the term of
four months from the 20th day of July 1836
until the 20th day of November 1836, that
he was honorably discharged from said ser-
vice and received for the same a Bounty
Warrant for 320 acres of land, which War-
rant is now on file in this Office together
with a Survey patented by virtue of the
same.
