

I was born in the State of Tennessee
A.D. 1815. Emigrated to Texas in the
year 1830. I was a member of Capt.
Albert Martin's Company in 1835. &
under the command of Col. Stephen
F. Austin, I was in what is called
the Grass Fight, and the fight at the
Mexican Conception. I was one of the
first four men sent from Gonzales
as Spies for the purpose of ascertaining
the movements of the Mexican Troops
at San Antonio. I was also in the
first fight of the Texas Revolution
at what is known as the Williams
place, commanded by John H. Moore.
I was also a member of Capt. George
Sutherland's Company. I was also in
Capt. Mathew Caldwell's & James H.
Callahan's Companies of Minute Men
and afterwards in the Battle of Plum
Creek, under the command of Col.
Felix Huston, and I was also in the
Battle of Salado, under the command
of Col. Mathew Caldwell, - and I am
now in the fifty ninth year of my
age.
