mained in service with said Company until  
the 4th day of October, 1836, the term for which  
the Company was enrolled; and that I, and  
said Company were honorably discharged at  
that date.

And, I furthermore solemnly swear  
that I am fifty-five years old, and consider  
myself justly and fully entitled to a pen-  
sion under the act of the Texas Legislature  
entitled "An act granting pensions to the  
surviving veterans of the revolution which  
separated Texas from Mexico" Approved Au-  
gust 13, 1870. - So help me God.
