a Justice of the Peace for the District of Lake Creek
Washington County in the Republic of Texas Personally
appeared James P. M. Farland who says the annexed
discharge is original just and true, and that he owes
the Government nothing for himself or any other person
Nor has he retained, sold or embezzled any Armes,
Munitions of War, or any kind of property whatever
belonging to the Republic of Texas or caused the same
to have been done

I know all men by these presents that I James P.
M. Farland do nominate authorize and appoint
John Pyle my lawful attorney and clothe him the
said John Pyle with full power and authority
to have my Account against the Government of
