Know Ye:

That Mr. J. O. Farrell of the
Madison Volunteers under Command of Mr. E.
Worrell and received into the Service of the
Republic of Texas by Brig General Rush
Commanding the Texian Army and whereas
enrolled on the 14th Day of May 1836 to serve
Three Months is hereby honorably discharged
from the Texian Army having served faithfully
and honestly the period of his enrollment
and is entitled to all the pay and all the
emoluments made and provided by Law
Given at Colletts on 16th 1836
