One "Stacy" initials not given, is shown as a Captain of the Mexican War from July 21, 1848, and was mustered out, Feb. 2, 1847.

Alfred Chandler is shown as a
Sd Sgt. in Col. J. D. Almy's 8d Regiment,
15th Brigade, Texas State Troops, enlisting
October, 1862.

F. J. Vance, Captain, Company I,
in Col. J. D. Almy's 8d Regiment, 15 Brigade,
Texas State Troops, from Collin County, Texas,
enlisted October, 1862.

The name of Oliver C. Secoy is given
as a Captain commanding a Company of volunteers
of Hallettsville, Lamar County, Texas, organized
in June, 1861.

J. H. Rice appears as a Private in
Capt. Oliver C. Secoy's Company, enlisting in
1861.

No other records can be located in the files
of this office.
