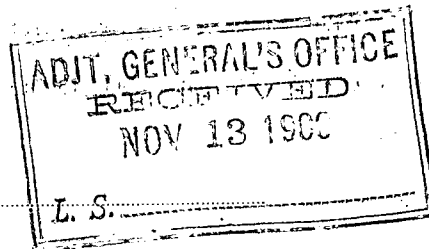

I was enlisted in the Front Batt Co F. on the 15th day of Jan 1882 Capt C. B. McKinney being in command of the Co. I served under Lieut Thudde at Yorktown, then Capt Lee was placed in command of Co. Wm Scott was 1st Lieut. and I was promoted to 1st Sergt in 1884 or 1885. Lieut Scott was then commissioned Capt and put in charge of Co. in 1888 he resigned, Lieut King being adjt Genl. I was commissioned and placed in command of Co. and have been in command of Co. ever since.

About 1886 I was under Capt McCurny 7th "B" during strike at
Horn. I was with Lieut Knight (Indian Police) protecting for mail
in the Indian Territory we were compelled to kill a man in
self defence. 1887 Capt Lieut. Rogers & myself were wounded
and Point Moore was killed while trying to arrest the Comanche
gang in Adkins Co. I was with Capt Lieut during the Peace
cutting trouble in Brown Co. ^{but I was not ordered when being captured were killed} I was in command of Company
during strike. I was in the field during the Sargento trouble
on the Rio Grande. Had one skirmish in Zapalla Co.
we were fired at from the brush twice but no one hurt.
Your service in the Texas Volunteer Guard or in the U. S. Volunteer Army in the war with Spain will be
verified by the records of this office.
we routed a band of ~~Indians~~ captured 9 horses & camp
outfit in Hidalgo Co. I prevented trouble at Cotulla in 1896

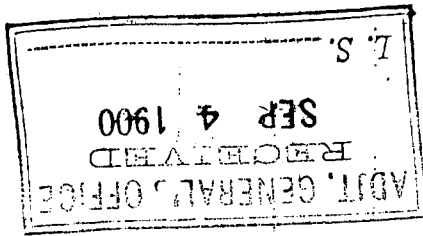

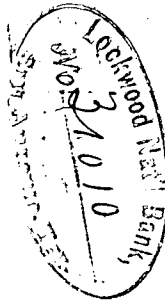
