

## **Magazines for Kids Available on BARD or from NLS**

This is a list of digital audio and braille magazines for kids that are available to either download on BARD or BARD mobile or available by mail from NLS and the Talking Book Program.

To find these in BARD and BARD mobile, follow these steps:

- Log-in
- If using the mobile app, choose “Get Books”, then “Browse Magazines”. Or choose “BARD Website” and do the remaining steps-
- Scroll down to FIND MAGAZINES AND OTHER MATERIALS
- Magazines by TITLE
- Use the drop-down menu to select the magazine
  - If you left the automatic settings, this list will show both audio and Braille options
- Once selected, you can add the title to your wish list, or download it just like you would for a book, or subscribe to the magazine

Another way to search is by using the “Most Recent Issues” link that appears just above the “Magazines by Title”. This ensures that the magazines you are browsing have had recent issues.

### **Cricket: The Realm of Imagination (CRI)**

- 9 issues/year
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD), ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Stories, poems, and articles by internationally known authors, plus songs, jokes, and crafts. For ages nine through fourteen.

### **Humpty Dumpty (HDM)**

- bimonthly
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD)
- Stories, poems, cartoons, puzzles, games, recipes, and crafts for kids ages three to five who are learning to read independently

### **Jack and Jill (JAC)**

- bimonthly
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD)
- Exciting stories, educational articles, and creative activities published for children. For ages six through twelve.

### **National Geographic Kids (NGW)**

- 10 issues/year
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD), ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Articles for children about people, places, customs, animals, and plants.

### **Scout Life (SCO)**

- monthly
- ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Articles on the outdoors, sports, and hobbies, plus adventure fiction and humor, for ages nine through sixteen. Published by the Boy Scouts of America.

### **Spider: The Magazine for Children (SPD)**

- 9 issues/year
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD), ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Stories, poems, jokes, and crafts for beginning readers ages six through nine.

### **Sports Illustrated Kids (SPK)**

- 11 issues/year
- digital audio (cartridge), digital download (BARD), ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Sports news and articles for ages eight through thirteen. Features sports personalities, events, and cards; youths who are excelling in athletics; and a regular column by youths discussing controversial sports-related issues

### **Stone Soup: The Magazine by Young Writers and Artists (STO)**

- 11 issues/year
- ebraille (BARD), press braille
- Stories, poems, illustrations, and book reviews created by children ages eight through thirteen. Features an activities section with suggested related projects
