Republic of Texas

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting.

I Minabeau B Lamar, President of the Republic of Texas, do hereby request all persons whom it may concern to permit the bearer ^{a Captain of the Saretahaw tribe,} here of *Sty-cu-lain*, freely to pass to the city of Santa fee, or any points near that city in the Republic of Texas, and to return to the city of Austin, or go elsewhere in the Republic of Texas, so long as he conducts himself with decency and in order, and in good faith towards the citizens of Texas, and in case of need to give him all lawful aid and protection

Given under my hand and the Great seal of the Republic of Texas at the City of Austin this ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty and of the Independence of Texas the fifth
