



Mrs. Jane Y. McCallum,
Secretary of State, gave
out the following state-
ment based on the official
records of her office:

“During Miriam Ferguson’s last twenty-nine days in office she granted full, unconditional pardons to 33 RAPISTS, 133 murderers, 124 robbers and 127 liquor law violators. During her last three days in office, from January 15, 1927, through January 17, 1927, she granted clemency in 160 cases, including full pardons to 35 violators of liquor laws, 40 robbers, 22 murderers and 10 RAPISTS.”
