SIZE: METRIC, FLY 103 ENGLISH, FLY 40 1/2"

HOIST 95 HOIST 37 1/2"

FIBER IDENTIFICATION: Cotton, silk

COLOR: Red, medium blue, white

METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: 17 eyelets

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) A dark red cotton field holds a 4" medium blue (faded blue green) cross with a 5" center star and 11 (one missing) white 3" silk stars.

(REVERSE)

A supporting fabric holds original cross and stars on the reverse of the flag.

CONDITION: (FACE)

General: Poor

Specific: Silk stars are missing. Only the outlines are visible. Original fragments are held by a supportive backing.

(REVERSE)

General: Poor

Specific: Missing areas of cross are evident. A supportive fabric holds remains of original flag.


PREVIOUS RESTORATION: This flag was placed on a supportive backing and (machine) stitched down.

PRESENT TREATMENT: Folded with acid-free paper in a box.



PROPOSED TREATMENT: This piece would require study to determine whether it could be returned to its original character.



