METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: Grommets, top and bottom on canvas

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) This machine stitched flag holds a field of white cotton. A red canton holds blue crossed bars outlined in white and thirteen (13) white stars.

Markings of black ink on the canvas hoist edge reads: "Battle of Mobile Bay; No 206; Wm Lona's Phil Museum Sale".

(REVERSE)

Crossed bars and stars are attached to the back side of the face fabric.

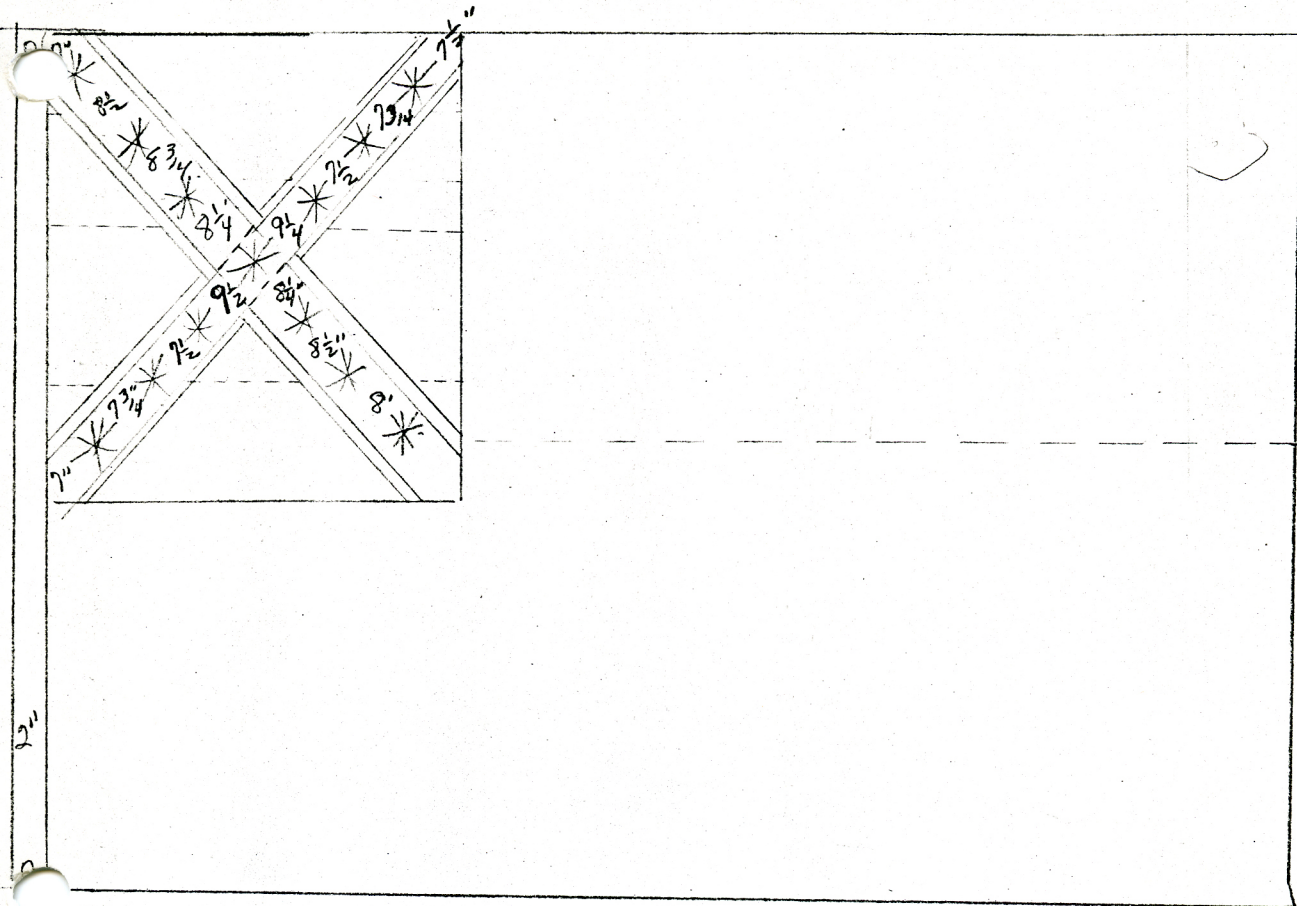

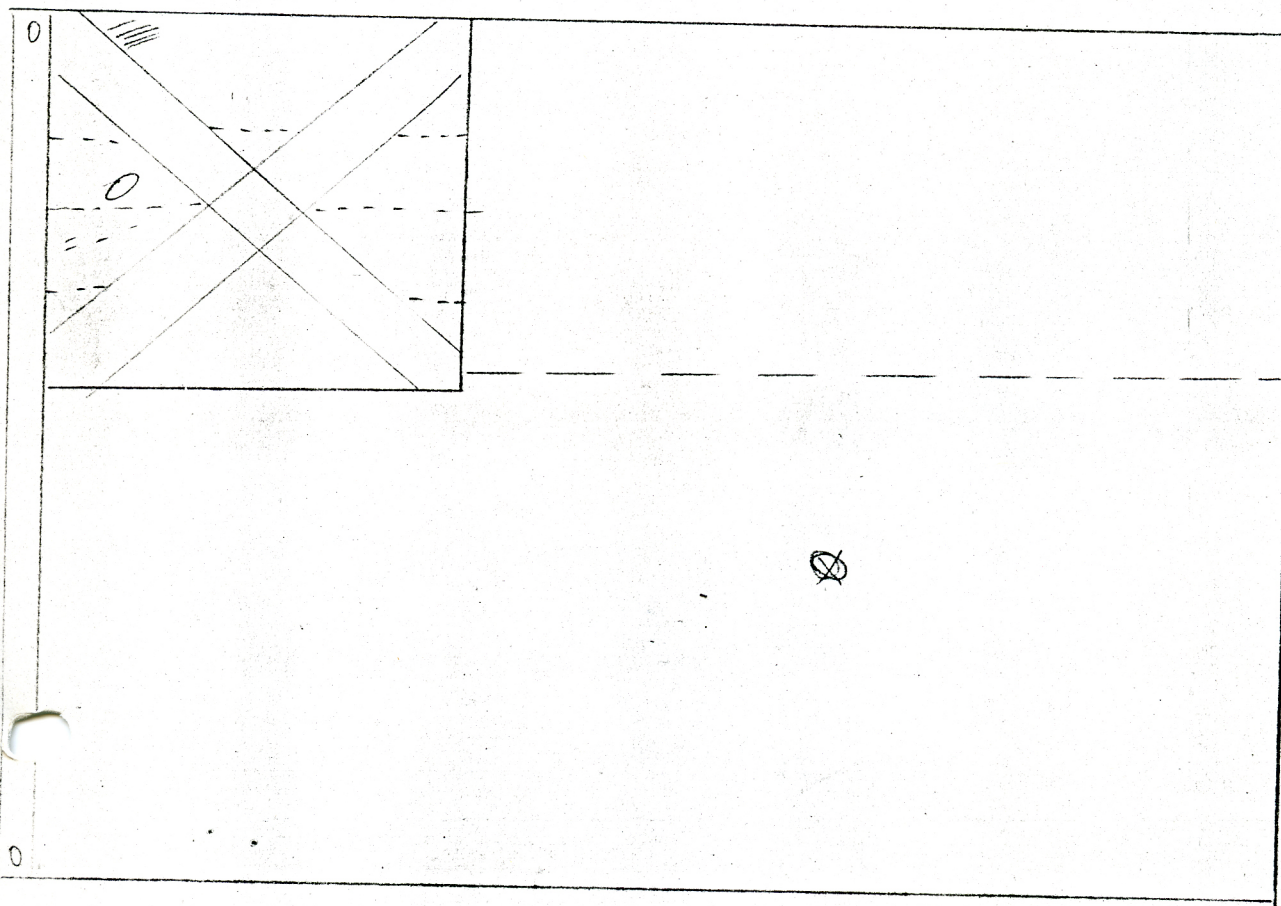

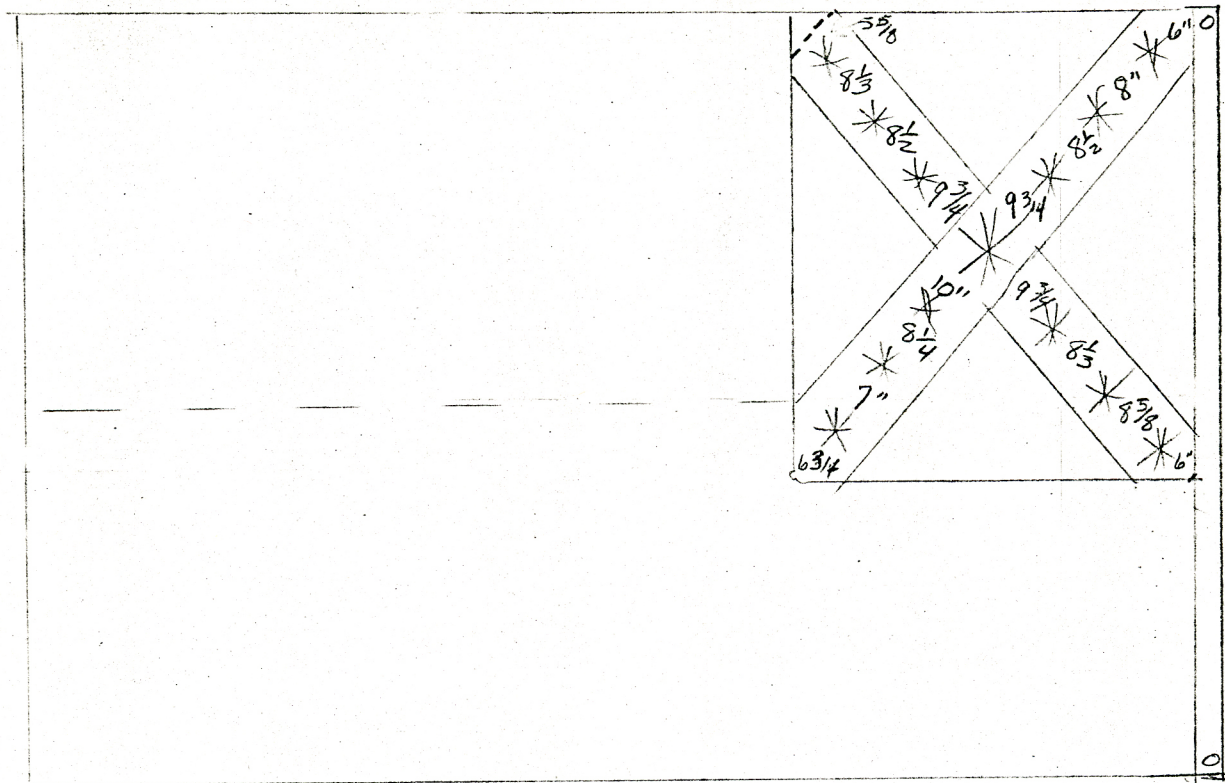
