COLOR: Olive green-photograph of this streamer prior to restoration shows a bluestreamer bordered on all sides with a 1/4" white silk

METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: _____

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) This olive green cotton streamer, having on its obverse the motto "Vivere Sat Vincere" in white embroidered Roman unical letters 1 3/4" high, slanting to the right. Rows of hem stitch have been applied directly to the streamer.

(REVERSE)

White Roman unical figure and letters 2 1/3" high with red chain stitch embroidered edge, and a 4" diameter white silk five pointed star bearing the script letters "T" "E" "X" "A" "S" in red chain stitching. The restorative stitching from the front is visible on the back.

ACCESSION NO. 25

CONDITION: (FACE)

General: Fair

Specific: Extensive stitching covers the banner. Holes have been stitched over.

(REVERSE)

General: Fair

Specific: Extensive stitching covers the streamer.

PREVIOUS RESTORATION: 13 rows of hem stitch hold streamer together. Discoloration of edges indicates former band of edges.

PRESENT TREATMENT: Folded with acid-free paper in a box.

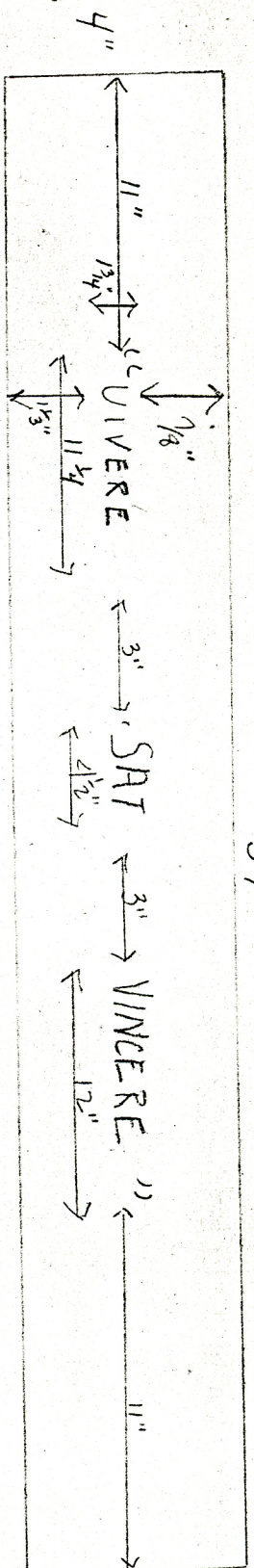

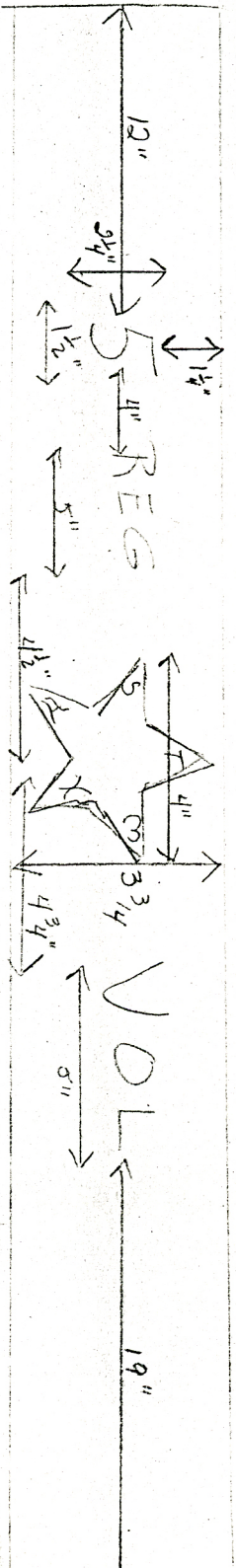
