FIBER IDENTIFICATION: Cotton bars with white silk stars

COLOR: Medium blue, white, and red

METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: Missing

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) The field is composed of three horizontal bars: red, white, red with "Texas" in 3 1/2" high Roman unical lettering, brown with a 1/8" red shadow, low and right in a shield on the white bar. A medium blue canton holds a large five pointed star which holds a center star and the points of the large central star hold two five pointed stars. The shield is painted with a brown outline; the star is yellow with red shading. The scrollwork is brown with red outlining. Heavy stitching is visible on the face.

(REVERSE)

There is a supportive backing fabric on the reverse.


PREVIOUS RESTORATION: Over-restoration of maching stitching the original fabric to a backing.

PRESENT TREATMENT: Folded with acid-free paper in a box.


