DESCRIPTION: (FACE) The flag holds three vertical bars. The staff bar is red, center bar is white, and the fly bar is green. The white center bar contains the embroidered shield of Mexico. Netting holds the green and white bars.

(REVERSE)

Reverse is the back of the face. Netting holds the entire flag.

Specific: The flag is severely brittle and flaking. Netting holds the green and white bars of the face. There are dark blood-like stains spotting the entire area.



PRESENT TREATMENT: Folded with acid-free tissue in a box.


