COLOR: Red, white, and blue

METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: Grommets, top and bottom

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) This machine stitched flag contains two (2) horizontal bars, red over white. A dark blue vertical bar holds a single white cotton star. The edges of the star are raw.

(REVERSE)

The dark blue vertical bar holds a white star.

CONDITION: (FACE)

General: Good

Specific: The blue bar has some tears and some small holes. The seam at the fly edge between the red and white bar is torn. The upper right quadrant fly edge is partially raw and torn. The lower right quadrant fly edge is also tattered

(REVERSE)

PRESENT TREATMENT: Folded with acid-free paper in a box.

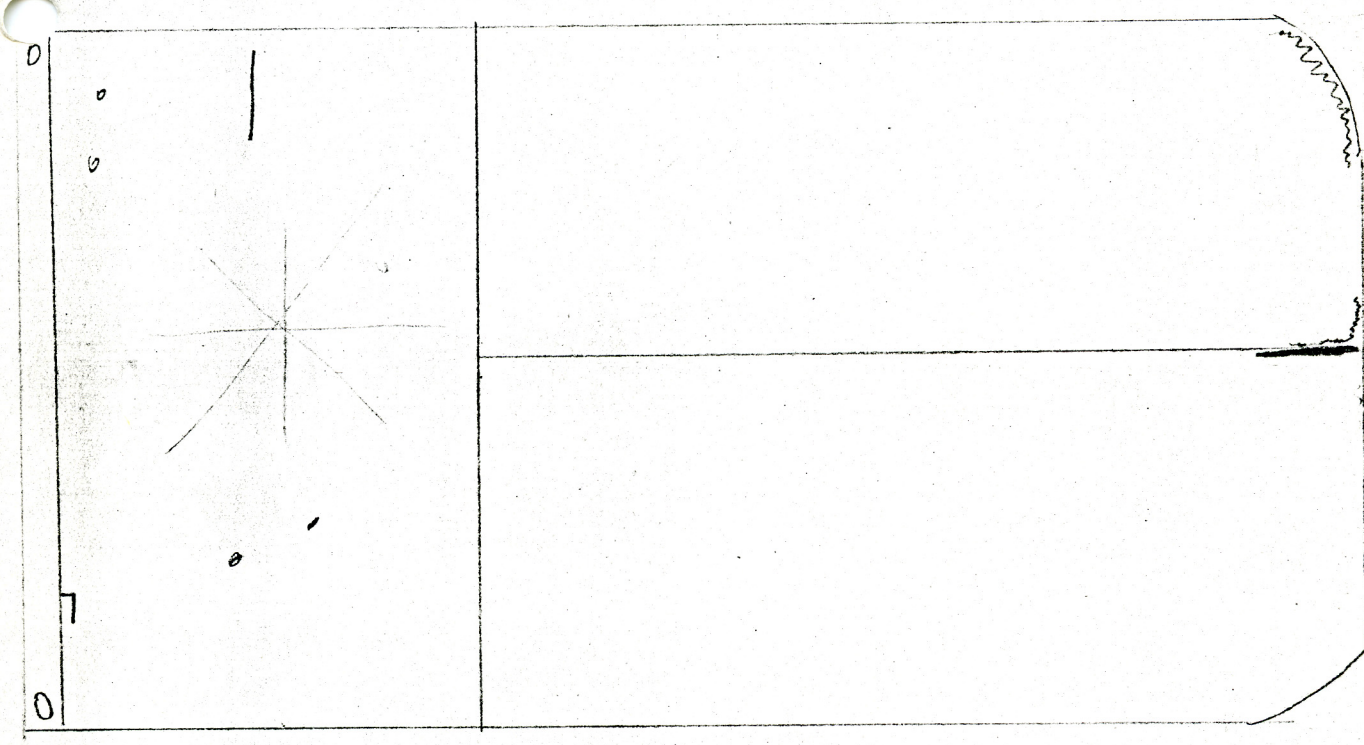
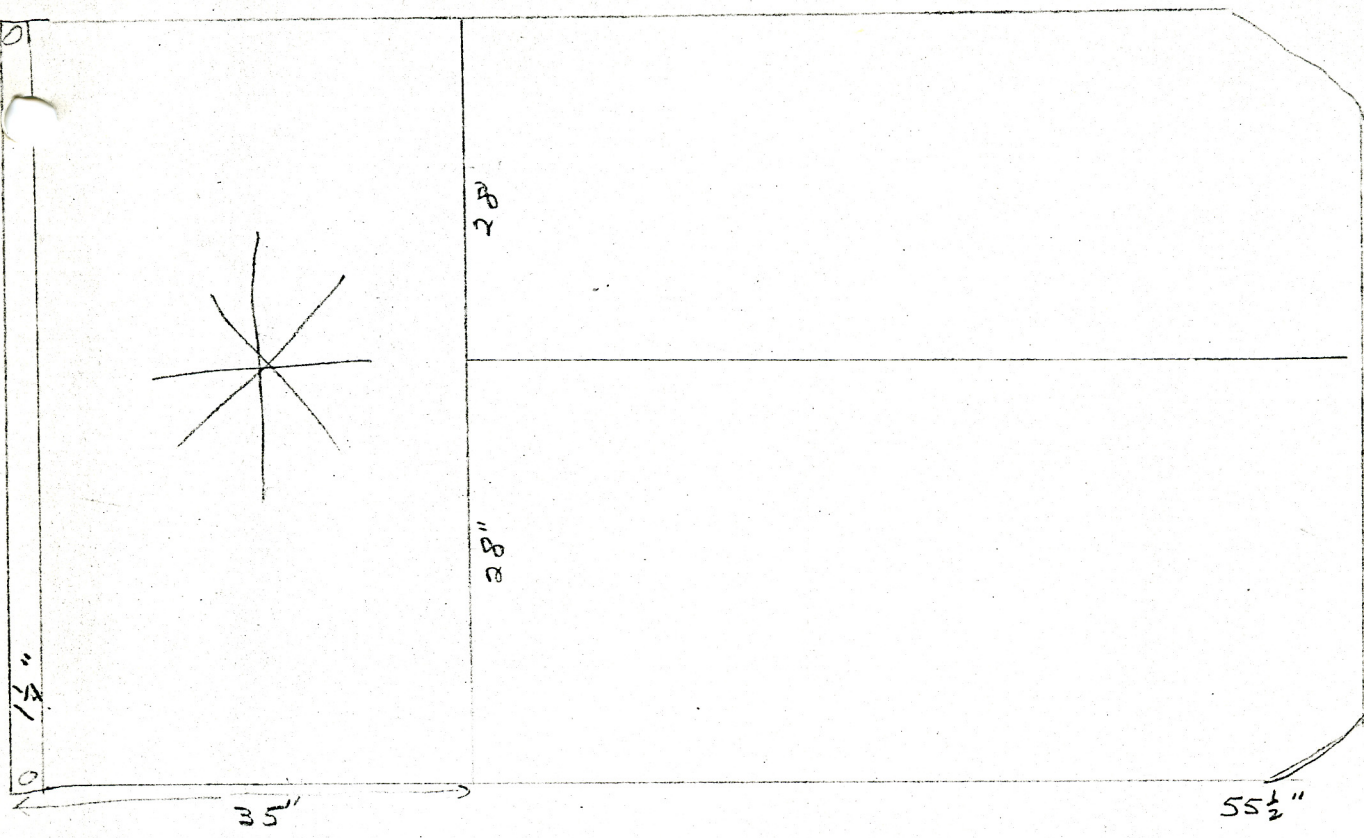
