FIBER IDENTIFICATION: Bunting

COLOR: Blue and white (greyed)

METHOD OF ATTACHMENT: Rope running through sleeve

DESCRIPTION: (FACE) This large swallow-tail Maxonic flag is composed of a white (greyed) field with a 9 1/2" blue strip on the upper edge and a 10" blue strip on the lower edge. The Masonic central devise of blue is surrounded by seven bunting five pointed stars. The stars and central devise are inset with flat felled seams. On the reverse of the canvass heading is a white cotton 1" x 2" label with the letters "Haverly" printed in ink. On the canvas heading also bears the lettering "No 2" in blue ink. Stitching has been done by hand.

(REVERSE)

The reverse is the back of the face.


