



As a Family Place Library, McAllen Public Library offers the following services at its Main location:

Parenting Collection: We offer books and other resources for parents and caregivers, on topics ranging from pregnancy through the teen years, nutrition, autism, potty training, & more!

Play Space: This specially designed area in our Children's Department offers many toys and manipulatives for babies and toddlers to explore. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to interact with their children and each other. Children must be accompanied by a parent or adult at all times in the play area.

Community Partners: MPL partners with community agencies to bring health information and best parenting practices to parents and caregivers in a friendly, informal setting.

Librarians & Library Assistants: We welcome new and non-traditional library users, especially parents and young children. Our Librarians are trained in family support, child development, parent education, and best practices. Our Library Assistants offer carefully curated programs and assist with answering your questions.

What is a Parent & Child Workshop?

The Parents & Child Workshop is a hands-on program that allows children to explore toys, art, music, and manipulatives. It is intended for children 1-3 years old and their parent or caregiver.

Parents and caregivers must register for the Workshop, which runs for five consecutive weeks.

What will you and your child get from attending the Parent & Child Workshop?

- * It will encourage you to interact and engage with your child.
- * You will meet other parents and have a chance to chat.
- * You will have opportunities to interact with local health and human service professionals and to ask questions.
- * Trained librarians will introduce you to the many resources the library has to offer.
