List of things covered by the Edge Reimbursement Program in the past:

Laptops, scanners, software (stand-alone, not subscription-based), printers, desktop computers, tablets, monitors, equipment installation and setup, wheelchair accessible computer desk, interactive whiteboard system, internet hotspot, projection screens, projectors, accessible trackballs for persons with disabilities, accessible keyboards for persons with disabilities, headsets, computer mice, combination printer/scanner/copiers, routers, stools, screen protectors, barcode scanners, charging station, sound system, storage carts, server, hard drives, privacy filter screens, digital cameras, mp3 players, computer carrels, as well as associated equipment to support purchases: surge protectors, cable chargers, laptop locks, batteries, and bags.

Please note that these have to be tied directly to Edge indicators -- so what might be approved in one library may not be approved in another.

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
