# **Server upgrades to cause TSLAC online library service interruption from July 31 – Aug. 1**

**AUSTIN** – The Texas State Library and Archives Commission (TSLAC) website (<http://www.tsl.state.tx.us/>) will experience service interruptions from Thursday, July 31 at 5 p.m., until 7 a.m., Friday, August 1, 2008 for the installation of new server equipment, to update software and execute routine site maintenance.

This will disconnect the TSLAC servers causing interruption to internal and external web-based services. All normal Internet services will be operational on Friday, August 1 at 7 a.m.

The interruption will affect the online services and links directly from the TSLAC website. TSLAC regrets any inconvenience to the general public, researchers and services to public libraries.

The TSLAC headquarters, the Lorenzo De Zavala State Archives and Library Building located at 1201 Brazos Street in the Capitol Complex, opened in 1962. It is currently undergoing a 2-year, \$15.5 million legislative appropriated renovation project.

The Friends of Libraries & Archives of Texas, a non-profit support organization of TSLAC is spearheading a \$10 million dollar campaign (Texas State Library and Archives Commission's Capital Campaign). The campaign is accepting pledges and donations for movable and freestanding archival shelving, furniture for patrons and staff, equipment, energy efficient lighting, recording booths for the Talking Book Program and a conservation lab expenses not covered by the legislative appropriation.
