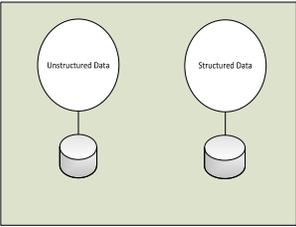

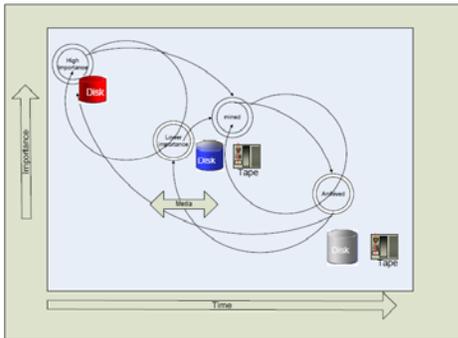

- Explore the cost savings of storage tiering and virtualization.
- Discuss implementing a content repository for large static data.

Propose a plan for infrastructure change with an associated migration plan

The Object Store

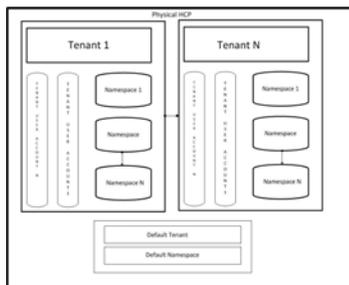
- Records as objects

- Ensures backward compatibility

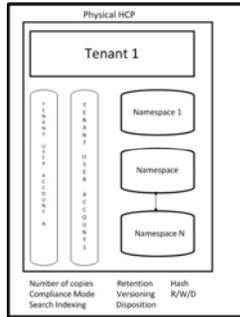

 - Search

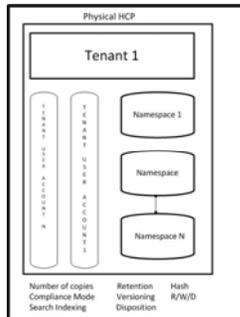
