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Introduction

Purpose and Scope

The *Texas State Publications 2003 Annual Index* compiles the entries found in the monthly issues of *Texas State Publications* published in calendar year 2003. *Texas State Publications* is a checklist of documents received by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission from state agencies, councils of government and institutions of higher education. The monthly checklist is intended as a reference source, current-awareness tool, and acquisition aid to the publications produced and distributed by Texas governmental organizations. It includes monographs, monographic series, annual and biennial serials, new periodical titles and leaflets or other ephemeral materials that are deposited with and processed by the Texas State Library during a month. Publications routinely excluded from the monthly checklist are: job announcements, news releases, bills, slip laws, opinions, daily journals, issues of periodicals, and exempt items. The annual index omits the latter publications as well as leaflets and ephemeral materials.

Arrangement

The checklist has two sections. The first section lists publications by issuing **agency**, arranged alphabetically by the key word in the agency's name. Agencies that contribute to the checklist include state agencies, departments, commissions, boards, legislative and judicial bodies, state-federal cooperating agencies, regional governmental councils, and state colleges and universities. Publications issued by state colleges and universities are grouped together following the agency listings. Each entry in the Agency List provides the following information when available or applicable: (1) issuing agency and its address; (2) Texas document classification number; (3) title; (4) author; (5) edition; (6) publication date; (7) pagination; (8) frequency; (9) series title and number; (10) title and content notes; (11) microfiche availability symbol; (12) OCLC record number; (13) depository availability symbol; and (14) entry number.

The second section is a **subject** index. Each publication is entered under the subject terms that reflect its content. The subject terms are Library of Congress subject headings as they are given in each publication's OCLC record. Additional terms have been added to the Subject List that will simplify access to certain forms of publications; these additional terms are: annual reports; biennial reports; budgets; college catalogs; consultant contract reports; financial reports; legislative appropriations requests; periodicals; and strategic plans.

The Subject List is arranged alphabetically by subject term, and within identical terms alphabetically by title. The alphabetical arrangement disregards punctuation and files "nothing before something." For example, the following terms appear in this order:

The exception to the above example is in the filing of subject terms that begin with the word "Texas"; in this case no rearrangement of terms has been made.

The Subject List is intended to be used in conjunction with the Agency List. Each entry in the Subject List includes the title or uniform title of the document, its classification number, and its entry number. The entry number can be used to find more complete bibliographic description of the document in the Agency List.

Distribution & Availability

The Texas State Library and Archives Commission sends copies of the publications it receives to its depository libraries, whenever possible, thereby enabling citizens to have ready access to Texas state publications in their local areas. To determine how a publication has been distributed, note the distribution symbol given with each entry; **(D)** indicates a Depository document that is available for loan from the Texas State Library and **all** state depository libraries; **(N)** indicates a Non-depository document that is available for use from the Texas State Library and Archives Commission.


Borrowing vs. Acquisition of Permanent Copies

The Texas State Library and Archives Commission has available for **loan** single copies of most publications listed. Publications showing depository distribution **(D)** are available from depository libraries throughout the state. A directory of State Depository Libraries follows this introduction. All publications can be obtained by local libraries through the state's interlibrary loan system. **Requests for permanent copies of publications must be directed to the issuing agency.** Each entry in the Agency List includes the agency's phone number and address for public information requests. Inclusion of a title on the checklist does not guarantee that an agency has copies available for general distribution.

Micropublishing Program

With few exceptions, **(N)** Non-depository publications can be purchased in microfiche format from the State and Local Records Management Division of the Texas State Library. The microfiche availability symbol, i.e. (2MF), that is displayed with each entry indicates the approximate number of fiche that was produced to represent the entire publication. Microfiche copies of a publication can be purchased for a reasonable cost.
