Challenged by professional detectives to find a priceless message hidden centuries ago in a hollow oak tree by a missionary, Nancy and her friends travel to Illinois. After being stalked by a shadowy enemy, Nancy pursues this dangerous adversary. For grades 4-7. 1935. English Braille, American Edition. Contracted braille.

The token is from Mrs. Phillips, and William and his friend Jason once again use it to return, through William's toy castle, to the medieval land of Sir Simon, a country menaced by a skeleton ship bearing a plague of evil. 1993.
