REMEMBER: Never post a username and password on your website!

- ❑ Set up IP authentication

Allows patrons inside your library to skip the login page. Just send us the broadcast IP address for your library and we'll do the rest.

- ❑ Consider patron Single Sign On Options

Allows patrons to log in with their barcode or a individual username and password. Options include EZproxy, OpenAthens, and Remote Patron Authentication through your catalog.

- Add LearningExpress links to your library website
 - Take advantage of FREE Staff Training from TSLAC and TexShare Databases vendors
 - Review Vendor Information Resource Guides
 - Follow the rules for Authorized Access
 - Promote the TexShare Databases
 - Offer training for your patrons, students, and faculty
 - Use free bookmarks and posters provided by the Texas State Library and Archives Commission
 - Modify downloadable bookmarks and posters provided by vendors
 - Track your patrons' usage
 - Get updates on the TexShare Users email list
 - Contact TexShare with any questions
