Product Description: The Gale Legal Forms Library is a web-based legal forms repository providing access to state-specific legal documents across the United States. The application is built on the Magento platform and includes form searching, browsing by category, downloading forms in multiple formats (MS Word, Rich Text, PDF), legal encyclopedia articles (Law Digest), lifestyle legal articles (LegalLife©), legal definitions, legal Q&A, attorney directory listings with practice-area drill-down, helpful topics articles with individual article content pages, tax form links, external resource links, and subscription management. The application also includes a Formspass Docprep module for online form completion, featuring a comprehensive forms index (Complete Online), a multi-step form entry wizard with inline validation, and a post-submission download/receipt page with embedded PDF preview. The site uses a consistent layout with a global header (desktop and mobile navigation), search functionality, breadcrumb navigation, sidebar with site navigation and popular search links, and a global footer.

Notes: This report covers the `accessible.css`-enabled version of the Gale Legal Forms Library and the `accessible-docprep.css`-enabled Formspass Docprep module. The accessibility layers are implemented via dedicated stylesheets (`accessible.css` for the main site, `accessible-docprep.css` for Docprep pages) that provide focus management, screen-reader-only text utilities, and enhanced visual indicators across all page types. The evaluation is based on a representative sample of 19 page types covering all major functional areas of the application, including the online form completion workflow (Docprep). Individual page-level reports are maintained separately and serve as the source documentation for this consolidated site-wide conformance report.

Evaluation Methods Used: Manual inspection of rendered DOM and accessibility tree via Chrome DevTools and Claude in Chrome browser extension; computed style analysis for all contrast ratios using the WCAG relative luminance algorithm; keyboard navigation testing (Tab, Shift+Tab, Enter, Escape, Arrow keys); Wave Accessibility Extension; Axe DevTools; NVDA screen reader verification; ARIA attribute verification on all interactive components (dialogs, tabs, navigation, forms, buttons, tables, checkboxes, live regions, step indicators, embedded objects); landmark and heading hierarchy audits; responsive reflow testing at 320px and 375px viewport widths; review of `accessible.css` and `accessible-docprep.css` stylesheets for focus management; `aria-controls` target existence verification across all pages; `aria-describedby` target existence verification; `aria-label` consistency verification across all subcategory links (361 items on Legal Q&A page); external link attribute verification across all external links (Tax Forms, External Links, Attorney Directory, Attorney Directory Listing pages); table structure verification (thead/tbody/th/td/scope/colspan on Attorney Directory Listing page); CSSOM rule inspection; inline validation trigger testing (focus/blur on empty required fields on Docprep form entry page); label-to-input association verification on Docprep form fields; `inert` attribute verification for mobile dialog focus trapping on Docprep pages; `autocomplete` attribute verification on Docprep personal data fields; `aria-invalid` state synchronization verification on Docprep form fields.
