



# Borrow materials from Texas libraries with the **TexShare Card**

The TexShare Card is a statewide library card that allows you to use materials in participating libraries throughout Texas.

A majority of Texas libraries participate in the TexShare Card program. Lending policies are set by each participating library. Specific policies are available at the Libraries and Catalogs link on the TexShare website:

# To take advantage of the **TexShare Card** program, just follow these simple steps:

- Register for and receive a TexShare Card from your library. A waiting period may be required.
- Consult the TexShare website to see the list of participating libraries and the specific lending policies of the library you wish to visit.
- Present your TexShare card at the library's circulation desk to activate your checkout privileges. You may be required to show a photo I.D. Please note that the card has an expiration date.
- Check out the books at the circulation desk.
- Return the materials to the lending library by the due date. Fees will be assessed for lost, late or damaged materials.
